Scholarship Program Guidelines and Information

 - a) NYAAE Member during the 2012-2013 school year.
 - b) Currently employed teaching agricultural education and be willing to teach a CASE course in a NY public school beginning in the fall of 2013.
 - c) Willing to share with other educators about their CASE Institute Experience and provide feedback regarding the program to Agricultural Education Outreach Staff. This may include participation in future professional development regarding the CASE program.
 - d) Attend the NYAAE 2013 Summer Conference
 - e) Agree to all CASE Institute Participant Expectations.

3. The scholarship applications will be evaluated and all applicants will be notified regarding the status of the scholarship application and if funds will or will not be awarded.

Educators may choose the CASE institute they prefer to attend that best meets their summer schedule and interests. **The value of this scholarship is \$1,250 and can be used to cover part of the tuition, travel to a CASE institute, or purchases from the CASE store to implement a CASE course for an institute you attend in 2013.**
6. **Each application submitted must include the following:**
 - a) Completed "2013 New York CASE Institute Scholarship Application Form;"
 - b) Essay (no more than 400 words) detailing applicant's interest in inquiry-based teaching/learning and applicant's desire to participate in the professional development for the CASE program.
